

## Swimming Pool Rules

- A. Lifeguards have full authority at the pool and surrounding areas.
- B. Unruly behavior such as shoving, running, diving or jumping from the lifeguard chairs, etc. will not be tolerated.
- C. Continued disrespect of rules or lifeguards will constitute a violation with the following action to be taken:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> violation – Suspended for the day
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> violation – 1 week suspended and parents contacted
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> violation – Suspended for the remainder of the summer and parents contacted
- D. A very serious violation waives the above statements and constitutes immediate suspension.
- E. Visitors must be accompanied by a member, unless they are a club registered baby-sitter accompanying member's children.
- F. **Every member** must register and charge their account for each guest.
- G. No one under 21 years of age will be allowed in the bar.
- H. Swimming with no lifeguard on duty is absolutely prohibited.
- I. No wet swim suits are allowed in the proshop or clubhouse.
- J. Shoes, shirts and/or swimsuit cover-up must be worn outside the pool area at all times. (This includes anywhere inside or around the building, except the pool restrooms.)
- K. Towels, toys or personal items left in the pool area will be discarded after 1 week.
- L. Each person is responsible for picking up his or her own trash.
- M. Members and their guests are not permitted to bring food and beverages to the Club. All food and beverages must be purchased from our clubhouse except on Mondays when the Clubhouse is closed.
- N. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- O. No pets allowed.
- P. Requirements of young children in the pool area are as follows:
  - 1. Children 10 years and under shall never be left unattended.
  - 2. Children ages 11 thru 14 must first pass an established swimming test for a lifeguard before being left unattended.

3. **Parents or attending person must watch their children at all times.** If this person is someone other than the parent and is not fully assuming the responsibility of watching the child, parents will be contacted to pick up the child.
  4. Babies in diapers and children too young to control bodily functions, cannot be in either pool without wearing disposable swimpants.
- Q. Swimming guest fees are \$7.00 per guest and no charge for grandchildren.
- R. Pool party rules are as follows:
1. Parties should be approved at least 1 week in advance by the pool chairman or the club manager.
  2. No party can begin before 6:00 pm unless approved by management.
  3. There must be 2 lifeguards on duty.
  4. To help supervise a child's party, there must be 1 adult present for every 10 children.
  5. All rules of conduct outlined above, will apply during any and all parties.
  6. Cost of the party will be \$120.00 for 2 hours with 2 lifeguards. Each additional hour will be \$20.00 and each additional lifeguard will be \$20.00.
  7. Per club rules, any food arrangements for parties must be made with management.

## Swimming Pool Schedule

The swimming pool opens the Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend and closes Labor Day.

The pool hours are as follows:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 10:00 am – 6:00 pm  
Wednesday and Friday 10:00 am – 8:00 pm  
Sunday 12:00 pm – 6:00 pm
